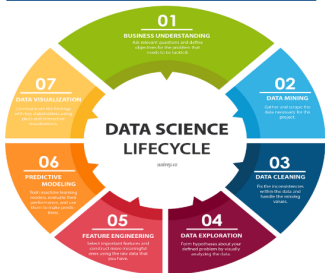

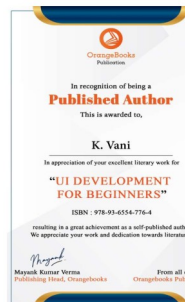
Additionally, students are allowed to undertake internships, providing them with meaningful industry exposure and strengthening their career readiness.

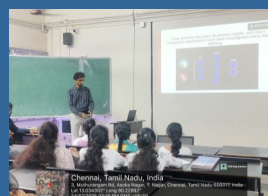
KNOWLEDGE ENRICHMENT

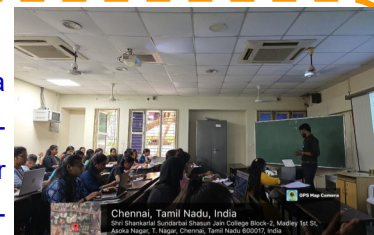

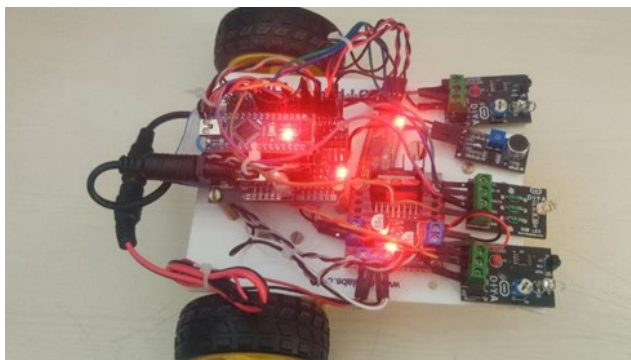
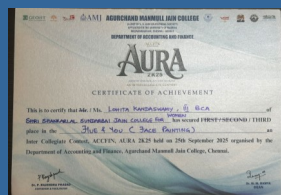


STUDENTS PARTICIPATION

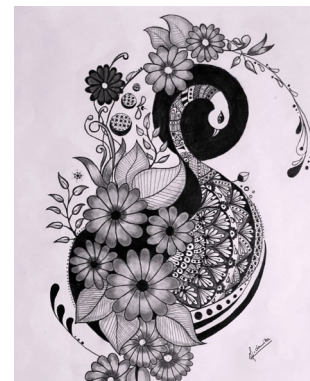
